EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Civic Leadership Institute participants are a mature, responsible, and highly motivated group, and we expect all students to meet the highest standards of behavior. To this end, participants must adhere to the Center for Talent Development's Summer Programs Honor Code. Students and parents are asked to sign a copy of the Honor Code as part of the acceptance process, so that all participants are aware of the program's expectations and their personal responsibility to contribute to a safe working and learning environment.

In addition to the CTD Honor Code, the Civic Leadership Institute has a set of specific program rules and policies. While the Civic Leadership Institute aims to give students a level of autonomy and responsibility commensurate with their age, the program is still highly structured and operates with a strict set of rules regarding campus and community boundaries and appropriate staff supervision. Please note that the daily schedule and residential rules and policies for the Civic Leadership Institute may vary slightly from other CTD Summer Programs, due to an older student population and a more urban setting.

The CTD Honor Code and Civic Leadership Institute program rules and policies will be reviewed with students at orientation, and enforced throughout the program. We expect all Civic Leadership Institute participants to be familiar with the rules, policies, and expectations set out for them in the Student & Parent Handbook and by instructional, residential, and administrative staff during the program, and to adhere to them in both letter and spirit. To help ensure their success in the summer program, students should NOT plan to participate in outside activities (such as sports practices, music lessons, SAT preparatory classes, etc.) during the Civic Leadership Institute.

Violations of the CTD Honor Code or of specific program rules and policies will result in consequences imposed by instructional, residential, or administrative staff members, guided by the Prescriptive Discipline Guide established for the program. Students who fail to live up to our expectations for behavior will be dismissed from the program, and sent home at their own expense. The prescriptive discipline guide, disciplinary procedures, and dismissal policy are also printed in the Student & Parent Handbook.

CTD HONOR CODE

Students enrolled in all Center for Talent Development Summer Programs must adhere to the CTD Honor Code. The Honor Code establishes standards and expectations for student behavior and reflects our commitment to fostering character development and integrity.
